(black tends to be rich in color and a good first option) amount needed 1-2 ounces feel free to get more if money is not an issue.</p> <p>Another good option is Ceramic pigments from Thompson enamel. https://thompsonenamel.com/product/oc-16-blue/</p> <p>One or two pigments is enough as a start.</p>
